

CMS REGULATION REQUIRES THAT PHARMACIES HAVE QUALITY ASSURANCE PROGRAMS IN PLACE

CMS Regulation 42 CFR 423.153 requires that pharmacies, who provide Medicare Part D prescriptions to beneficiaries, have established quality assurance measures and systems in place to reduce medication errors and adverse drug interactions, as well as, improve medication use.
